Social development portfolio committee demands answers on how head of department at health was appointed

THE health and social development port-folio committee has demanded answers on how embattled head of department at health, Dr Thabo Lekalakala was

on how embattled head of department at health, Dr Thabo Lekalakala was appointed.

Lekalakala is presently on special leave as a forensic investigation on the department following the Mediosa and other scandals is ongoing.

The committee said it had written to MEC, Dr Magome Masike, the general director and the health minister to confirm if Lekalakala was ever a chief director as written on the Z83 form he used to apply for the top post.

The acting head of department, Vuyo Mbulawa, told the committee on Tuesday that MEC Masike had requested Dr Lekalakala to take his annual leave while all issues raised against him are being investigated by the province's general director, Dr Lydia Sebegoe.

The committee had requested the department to come and present the final draft of the annual performance plan (APP), give a brief on the appointment and shed light on the ongoing Nehawu strike.

The committee said the health department to could only attend to it after the AG had seen it.
